We recommend you collect all your information in a Word document and copy and paste into the form. You cannot save the form and come back to it. In particular, it's worth having written your project summary and project description in advance.

About you

Your project

Tell us about your peer-reviewed discovery, invention, or results. Why is what you've discovered cool? Novel? Different? Exciting? When you're trying to convince people that your work is amazing, what do you tell them?

If you're selected for Fresh Science, this discovery will be what you present to journalists in the training session, as well as at the school forums and at the pub night. It will also be the focus of your profile, and possibly even a media release.

Fresh Science concentrates on one discovery, not body of work. We want significant results, not intentions. We'll prioritise research that's produced peer-reviewed results.

- Project title
- Your preferred headline (8 words or less)
- Project summary (elevator pitch; 60 words or less)
- Project description (more detail, up to 400 words)
- Publicity to date
- Collaborators, if any
- Any photographic and visual material

Evidence of peer review

- Publications, conference presentations, patents, etc. At least one peer-reviewed piece of work, and up to three (pick your best).

About your referees

- Two referees: Full name, position, organisation, email address (a second referee not required if you have named a nominator).

Any special circumstances

- Please let us know if you have any special circumstances, such as a career-break, which you'd like us to take into account.
